Problems with Windows 7 or higher

Due to higher security rules in Windows 7 or higher, you should start GuardPointPro by right-click on the application shortcut icon and select the option "Run as administrator" (see attached image). Otherwise, it is possible that Windows does not modify the original application files but creates them in a temporary directory instead.
