

Configuring Microsoft SQL Server

To ensure smooth operation of the VantagePoint you must configure some SQL Server components.

1. Execute 'Start->Programs->Microsoft SQL Server 2008->Configuration Tools->SQL Server Configuration Manager' in windows.

3. In 'Protocols for MSSQLSERVER', set 'Shared Memory', 'Named Pipes', 'TCP/IP', and 'VIA' Enabled. At each protocol, choose 'Enabled' clicking with the right mouse button.
